THE SHELL-OPERATED QGC VENTURE IS LOCATED IN QUEENSLAND IN EASTERN AUSTRALIA.

We're one of Australia's leading natural gas producers, focused on developing Queensland's world-class onshore gas reserves.

QGC has supplied the domestic market since 2006 and international customers since 2014.

We operate an 8.5 million tonne per year LNG plant on Curtis Island near Gladstone, and natural gas operations, which include wells, compression stations and processing plants, in Queensland's Surat Basin.

Shell is the operator and majority interest holder in the QGC venture. Our partners in the LNG plant on Curtis Island are CNOOC (50% equity in Train 1) and Tokyo Gas (2.5% equity in Train 2).

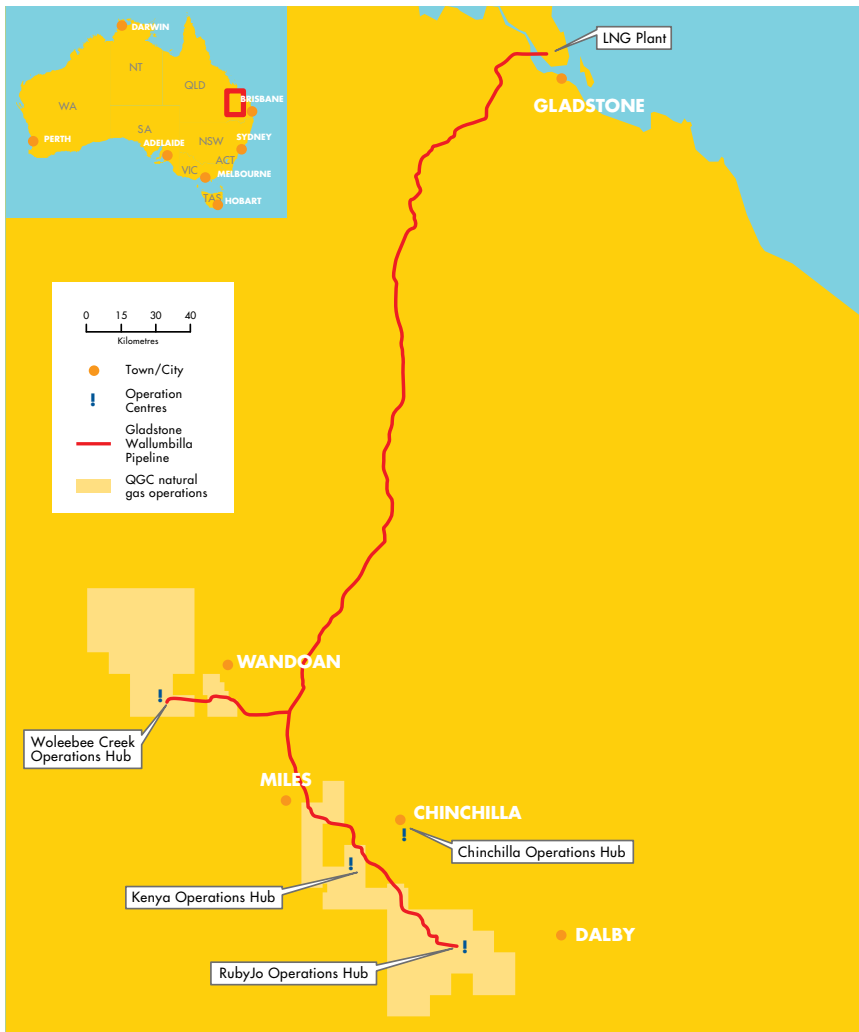
