September Train 2 inspection • Bushfire hazard reduction burn planned for late June or early July (dependant on weather) – bordering area between APLNG and QGC • Curtis Island RFS Incident Command, LNG Operations Bushfire Management Plans • Local winner for global ConocoPhillips award (2017 Global Supplier Recognition Award) – Xtreme Engineering (COP Corporate Global Supplier) and Contract Resources (Asia-Pacific)

Procurement staff visibility of local and indigenous businesses • Ecofest – 350 adults and 150 children visited QGC tent, 180 surveys completed • Project Goog-a-binge: undertaking design work for next gas field development. If approval is successful, the project will be called Goog-a-binge ('scrub turkey in Iman language) Taking place in Iman traditional country. In recognition, Iman elders have provided this name • Employee Grants – Shell offers \$50 grants for employees to donated to NFP of choice.
