<p>APLNG Update</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Operations update provided by Wendy King • Train 2 and 1 shutdowns in April/May successfully completed • Rate reduction for Train 1 (July - August), September Train 2 inspection • Domestic market: APLNG provided 30% of East Coast natural gas supply during 2018 winter • Federal Govt: Heads of Agreement - The Australian East Coast Domestic Gas Supply Commitment was signed (Prime Minister Morrison and Australia Pacific LNG, QCLNG and GLNG reps) on 28/09/18 to supporting gas supplies to the domestic market • In the event of a shortfall, all three LNG exporters agreed to offer uncontracted gas to the domestic market on competitive terms • Global ConocoPhillips award (2017 Global Supplier Recognition Award) – Xtreme Engineering, Gladstone based business • Workforce volunteering and matched giving: funds provided to organisations where our workforce volunteers and dollar-for-dollar donations provided to organisations chosen by our workforce • Local contributions FY 2018: + \$81M spent with Gladstone businesses (registered in 4680 region) • Employs 147 locals, supports an additional 100 direct contractor roles • Contributed more than \$1.5 million in community investment • Contributed more than \$5 million to the Gladstone Regional Council and \$16 million to GPC through rates, fees and charges
