<p><b>Shell's QGC Business Update</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Overview of Train 1 May maintenance (string outage) – 15,000-man hours, 1.5 weeks, ~110 additional, short-term roles; majority local workforce with balance being non-local specialists; no smoky flaring</li> <li>• Rebrand is underway with Shell pecten appearing alongside the current blue QGC logo. Gradual rollout in community with old orange BG Group signage gradually replaced</li> <li>• Community Engagement: Ecofest, 800 people attended Shell QGC stall with ~280 community surveys completed</li> <li>• Shell's QGC Communities Fund: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ opens July 1 with information sessions held in Gladstone and Agnes Water. Applications required by COB 31 August</li> <li>◦ recent completion of community projects from 2018 funding round included Tanyalla Recreation Centre (deck extension to hall); Discover Coast Tourism and commerce (1770 Stage extension); Benaraby Progress Association (Hall upgrade)</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Second round of laptops available for donation to not-for-profits. Majority have been committed after EOIs received.
