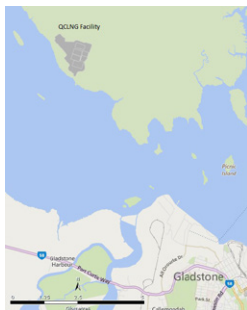
Application notice

Queensland Curtis Liquefied Natural Gas (QCLNG) - LNG Facility

Resource activity: site specific petroleum activity

It is advised that QCLNG Operating Company Pty Limited has lodged an application for a major amendment to an environmental authority in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Act 1994. The environmental authority being amended is EPPG00711513.

The application relates to the QGC LNG plant that is located on Curtis Island about 10km northwest of Gladstone. The application seeks to amend QGC's current environmental conditions for the required flaring associated with essential maintenance shutdowns and process upsets, and seeks to increase the authorised duration of visible smoke emissions. An amendment to the current limits on flaring would enable QGC's LNG plant conditions to be consistent with the conditions seen for other LNG facilities in Australia, and would reflect the actual operating conditions involved in the LNG facility when operated safely as per design.
