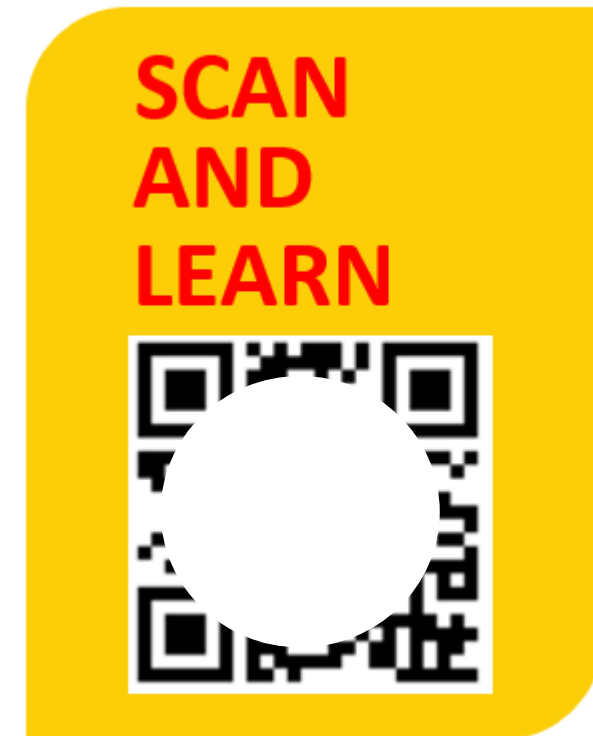




QR Code Quick Access Guide

WHAT IS A QR CODE

- A QR code is a type of barcode that links directly to a piece of information; QR codes are intuitive and provide you with access to information with ease.
- Each QR code is unique and links to specific information allowing direct access to the right information every time.
- The QR code provides you access to information in an easy and time effective way, without having to download a separate application or remember a website.



HOW TO GUIDE

USE ANY SMART PHONE OR SMART DEVICE TO SCAN A QR CODE

- Open the camera function on your smart phone or device
- Position your camera over the top of the QR code
 - A pop up will appear
- Click on the pop up prompt and access to the relevant data will appear.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Lifting is not restricted to large work fronts, and large machinery. Lifting equipment can include (but not limited to), forklifts, winches, hoists, slings.
- Incidents do not only occur during complex lifting activities, think about the regular lifts that take place each day (*unloading and loading trucks, lifting pipe*); These activities, although not considered complex, pose the same risk. How will imbed learnings to stay safe?

HOW WILL I BENEFIT FROM USING QR CODES

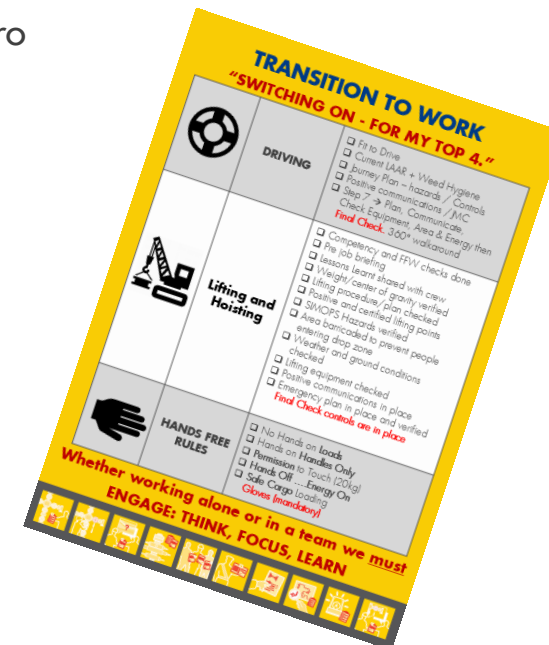
PURPOSE

- The purpose of the QR code is to provide access to information in an easy and time effective way; Without having to download a separate application or remember a website.
- The codes will be placed on relevant equipment in the field, so information is available in real time for tasks you are able to complete
- Note at this stage, the QR codes LFI information is only based on Lifting and Hoisting. If you like the use of QR codes, see a benefit and would like to see it used more broadly across the business please provide feedback through the pulse surveys that will be conducted in coming weeks.

HOT TIP:

- Use the QR codes when you see them as part of your Step 7 conversation. QR codes in the field will be directly linked to a relevant LFI, use this as part of your Step 7 conversation and review and discuss learnings that will be relevant to the task you are about to complete.
